
About Tony Dungy

Tony Dungy is the No. 1 New York Times bestselling author of “Quiet Strength,” “Uncommon,” and “The Mentor Leader.” He led the Indianapolis Colts to a Super Bowl victory on February 4, 2007, the first such win for an African American head coach. Dungy also made NFL history by becoming the first head coach to lead his teams to the playoffs in 10 consecutive years. Dungy joined the Colts in 2002 after serving as the most successful head coach in Tampa Bay Buccaneers’ history. He has also held multiple assistant coaching positions. Dungy has been involved in a wide variety of charitable organizations, including All Pro Dad. He retired from coaching in 2009 and now serves as a studio analyst for NBC’s Football Night in America. He and his wife, Lauren, married in 1982 and are the parents of 11 children.
